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About us

The Minobimaadizing Addiction Recovery Program at Maamwesying North Shore Community Health Services, offers non-judgmental support for those struggling with Mental Health and substance use, using a culturally-driven and holistic approach. Part of recovery is addressing issues with a sense of immediacy and we can accommodate those individuals looking to take on treatment immediately. We will get you set up with services and resources you need and provide ongoing support in your recovery.

- Treatment of all substance use disorders, including marijuana, alcohol, opioids, stimulants, etc.
- Suited for adults who are 18 years of age or older
- Must have a valid health card
- All are welcome at 123 March Street, Suite 503

Services offered on site

- Medical examination and laboratory tests
- Urine drug screening
- Initial intake
- Treatment contract and plan
- Regular medical follow up (OTN)
- Addiction counselling
- After care programming (i.e. relapse prevention)
- Naloxone kits

In addition to our program we can offer referrals

- Registered physiotherapists and occupational therapists for pain management in collaboration with Community Support Services
- Traditional Health Practitioners (THPs)
- Access to a Nurse Practitioner
- Mental health counselling and treatment
- Residential treatment programs

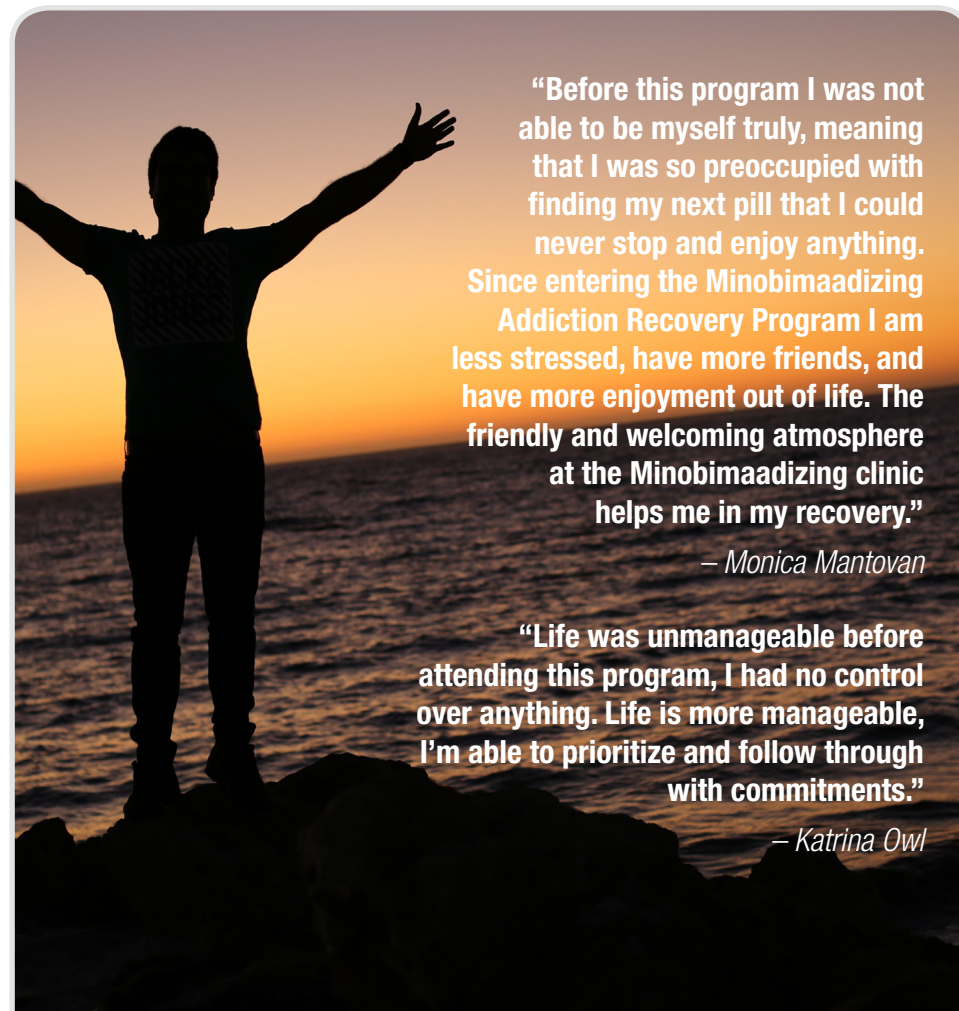
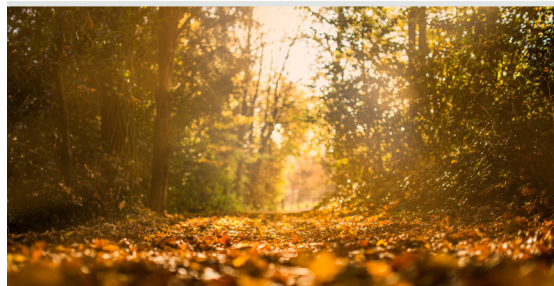
Did you know?
