Under the supervision of the Mental Wellness Program Manager, the Mental Wellness & Addictions Clinician is responsible for providing culturally appropriate crisis intervention and addictions counselling services to clients experiencing acute crisis. The Mental Wellness & Addictions Clinician shall assume a technical support role in building on current relationships between traditional Aboriginal and western healing modalities through cultural awareness and translation activities as well as supporting the access of traditional healers for individual clients.

Qualifications:

- Minimum Honors Bachelor of Social Work (HBSW) or relate degree with minimum 2 years' experience working in addictions and with Indigenous community
- Masters Degree of Social Work preferred
- Member of Ontario College of Social Works and Social Service Worker or relevant governing college
- Experience in Psycho-educational and Psychotherapy group facilitation experience
- Must have proven counselling experience with all age groups experiencing acute crisis and addictions issues
- Thorough knowledge of addictions based resources, including ability to administer and score relevant treatment based questionnaires and experience providing support at various stages of recovery
- Knowledge of First Nation service delivery, customs and traditions
- Knowledge of external services and service agencies
- Must be able to work flexible hours, including evenings and weekends
- Must possess a valid driver's license and access to a reliable vehicle;

Given the traditional practices of Aboriginal people, from time to time exposure to smoke from the burning of sacred medicines such as tobacco, sweet grass, sage or cedar may occur.
