

## Minobimaadizing Care Coordinator, RPN

Maamwesying North Shore Community Health Services, an Aboriginal Health Access Centre that provides primary health, traditional healing, mental wellness & addictions counselling, home and community support services and health promotion services to community members of the seven First Nations of the North Shore Tribal Council, is inviting applications for a highly motivated **Registered Practical Nurse** to join their Mental Wellness & Minobimaadizing team.

Under the direction and support of the Minobimaadizing Program Manager the RPN – Minobimaadizing Care Coordinator plays a critical role in the delivery of our Addictions Withdrawal Management which focuses on administering medication, supporting clients with their withdrawal management from substances, relapse prevention: transition and after care. The scope of this service is to provide clinical and clerical support to our primary health care Addictions Specialist and to coordinate client-centred shared –care services within an integrated-disciplinary team to community members seeking and accessing Mental Wellness and Addiction services.

### Qualifications:

- Registered Practical Nurse College Diploma and current registration in good standing with the College of Nurses of Ontario as a Registered Practical Nurse is required
- Current CPR and First Aid Certification
- Ontario Telemedicine experience an asset
- Specialization in prescription drug abuse or polysubstance abuse would be an asset
- Demonstrated ability to develop and facilitate health teachings and presentations for health promotion and awareness related to prescription and illicit drug abuse.
- Knowledge of community based health care deliver. Knowledge of interest in the health issues affecting Anishnawbe people. Cultural awareness and sensitivity training an asset.
- Must be able to work flexible schedule including evenings and weekends.
- Must have access to a reliable vehicle and a valid G Class driver's license.

*Given the traditional practices of Aboriginal people, from time to time exposure to smoke from the burning of sacred medicines such as tobacco, sweet grass, sage or cedar may occur.*

- Accommodations for the disabled will be available upon request
- An offer of employment will be conditional upon an acceptable vulnerable sector police records check.
- Hiring of Aboriginal People will be given preference, as allowed under Section 14 of the Ontario Human Rights Code – Special Programs
