

## Summer Graduate Student Opportunity

Maamwesying North Shore Community Health Services in partnership with Noojmowin Teg Health Centre has an exciting summer student opportunity for an Indigenous student currently enrolled either in a graduate program or upper year undergraduate program to support the work of the Models of Indigenous Dementia (MInD) Care research project team.

The Models for Indigenous Dementia (MInD) Care project builds on the experience of community-based participatory action research and Indigenous research methods to find the gaps in services, resources, and support for Anishinaabek adults aged 45 and older living with dementia through the lens of their caregivers. Primary caregivers from communities on the North Shore and Manitoulin Island will give a first-hand account of their lived experiences caring for their loved one with dementia. Moreover, a thorough examination of services, resources, and support offered at the local, district, provincial, and national levels will be undertaken.

The successful candidate will work alongside Dr. Jennifer Walker of the Laurentian University Research Lab and the First Nation community partners to undertake an environmental scan, describing all the dementia care services, resources, and supports that are offered to Anishinaabek people of Manitoulin Island and the North Shore. During their time with the research team, the student will have access to training opportunities to build their skills and capacities related to the work involved in performing the environmental scan, as well as various Indigenous research methodologies.

Due to COVID-19 restrictions, it is highly likely that the student will work from home. A laptop computer with appropriate software will be provided.
